Deferred Payment Plan

The deferred payment plan is available for those who are unable to pay the full tuition and fees at the beginning of the semester, by making a Deferred Payment Agreement with the university. Under this arrangement, the student/parent/guardian may pay tuition and fees in specified installments over a period of 3 months. Any charges that are not covered under the deferred payment agreement are due and payable upon registration.

The Deferred Payment Plan comprises of only two options:

Option 1: Unequal monthly payments installment plan - This option allows the parent to defer 40% of the total charges. A minimum of 60% of all charges (Tuition and fees) is due at the start of the semester to finalize registration.

The 40 % that is then deferred is divided into two (2) monthly unequal installment payments, one of 60% of the remainder, and the second of 40% of the remainder. A 5% service charge on the total deferred outstanding balance is assessed on the total deferred amount. Timely payment must be made; a late charge of 30,000 Naira is assessed for each month late payment. Of the two available options, this is the less expensive one.

Option 2: Equal monthly payment plan - Under this option Parents/Guardian/Students may divide tuition and fees into three monthly installments starting at the beginning of the semester, paying 33% of the tuition/fee at the start of the semester.

The remaining two payments each carry a service fee. This makes this option somewhat more expensive, in total, than the Unequal Payments installment plan.

*Both options require a down payment that must be made at the time you return the deferred payment plan agreement
